

## SYNOPSIS

A father of a 12 y.o. boy Ilya from an educated family gets killed. However, the murderer, Vitka the Ogre, does not go to prison, but sends his brother instead of himself.

At the same time Petr arrives in the village with his wife Nastya. Petr is planning to open a sports school there. The house, in which they were going to start a new life, turns out half-destroyed, but they decide to stay.

The whole village knows that Vitka was the murderer, but considers it normal that the criminal is freely walking all around the village.

However, Ilya resists the injustice and decides to get revenge.

In an attempt to revenge, the boy nearly gets killed. Petr stands up for him. Petr encourages Ilya to take up biathlon. Ilya agrees but requests a deal in return: Petr will cooperate to help murder Vitka, when Ilya hits 5 out of 5. Petr agrees. He cannot even imagine having to deliver on a promise.

Meanwhile things are going well for Vitka. He falls in love with Nastya. People in the village gossip about Vitka and Nastya, so Vitka becomes Petr's number one problem.

Ilya frequents the training diligently. Petr wins his trust and love. However, the idyllic days are over when the young sportsman hits 5 out of 5. Ilya requests his teacher to deliver on a promise – let's go kill Vitka. Petr's refusal is a betrayal in his eyes.

## ABOUT WHAT

"The Riot" is a social drama with comedy elements about the society's tendency to preserve its status quo at all costs, indirectly benefiting from the presence of the criminal. Vitka the Ogre and Sanya are former friends. Sanya has a hard time living, but he's scared to put an end to his life. He calls Vitka a "faggot" and gets killed for it. Those are the unwritten "rules" of the criminal world: for calling someone a "faggot", you die. And yet Vitka did not go to prison – he's already been there. Vitka's younger brother went to prison instead. And this is because the same "rules" make the prison a means of social mobility - a place that "gives you a chance" and defines your fate.

Petr and Nastya enter this world like a fine surgeon knife's blade. And yet, as much as Petr tries to rattle up the locals by opening his sports school, he fails to change the system. The system is changed by Ilya – Sanya's little boy. Ilya exists in the invisible zone of the local community - the zone beneath the "window" – and he does his best to draw attention to the fact that Vitka's crime remains unpunished. But the villagers have no use for the boy. Sanya is just a fatherless kid, while the killer is a veterinarian- an asset to the village.

Neither Petr, nor Ilya can prevail over Vitka on their own – only the community can endow them with that power by fully accepting Petr. This is why the story is not about them, it's about us.

# THE RIOT

The Overton Window - this term defines the range of existing opinions about ethical questions in all kinds of societies: national or local. underdeveloped or socially advanced. Most people do not wish to see or experience anything that exceeds the frames of the "window" outlined by their environment. If something extraordinary does happen, there are two options - to either eliminate the transgressor or to pretend that nothing has happened.


